EARTA CONSTITUTION/BYLAWS

It's that time ... to update and make necessary changes in our Constitution/Bylaws. We (general membership) will vote on these changes at the April luncheon to include the updates and changes in the 2025 Directory.

Most of the changes are editorial in nature or for aligning practice with policy. There are three major changes:

- 1. Eliminate four Board of Directors positions and add two.
- 2. Distribute the Directory in June of odd numbered years instead of February of every year.
- 3. Eliminate the whole Retired Teacher of the Year section.

Specific changes will be available in print at the luncheon tables for your reading enjoyment. The Board of Directors has voted to approve these changes.

The State Legislature is busy during March introducing bills, getting committee assignments for their bills, and using the April committee time to review and recommend legislation for vote on the chamber floors.
