Legislative Report - 9/2024

At the September 19th general meeting, the Legislative chair gave an oral report to the assembled group which covered several communications from IRTAPAC and the IRTA legislative committee. Below is a summary of the main points from that report. More information is always available at IRTA online.org/member.

See the Handout for the IRTAPAC endorsed candidates in your area. Those legislators are the only ones who pledged to support your pension. (Copy below.)

September 5th, the IRTA legislative committee met via zoom. Two or three takeaways from that meeting: Andrew Bodewes (IRTA Lobbyist), reported: "Most of the IRTA goals were met this year without legislation, but for this fall IRTA is working to help provide retirement security for Tier II retirees." Jessica Hoselton (IRTA Executive Director) stated that IRTA is working with Central Management Services (IL state decision makers) to lock down details of the two new insurance benefits (vision & dental) that are expected to take effect in 2025.

Lastly, with this being election season, the State Legislature will not resume until the Veto session scheduled after the November elections.
